



Recycled Tin Can Windsocks

Kids love a bit of recycling and they love a bit of a craft activity. So why not combine the 2 and make this tin can windsock. It's colourful, quick and easy and they look fantastic!

Tip: line the inside rim of the cans with a layer or two of thick masking or duct tape to avoid sharp edges!

MATERIALS

Clean Recycled Tin Can
(any size will work!)

Acrylic Paint & Paintbrushes

Glue or a Low-Temp Glue Gun

Assorted Ribbons (you could also use String, Colored Paper, etc.)

Optional embellishments like Glitter, Stickers, Gemstones, Sequins, etc

Masking Tape or Duck Tape

STEP 1.

Start by painting the can in colors of your choice.



We went with a rainbow color scheme over here, but you can use any colors that you prefer!



STEP 2.

After the paint is dry, use glue to attach colorful ribbons to the bottom rim of the can. We also added a ribbon to the top of the can for hanging.
