Kawaii is everywhere these days, so why should rocks be left behind! Make your own Kawaii food rocks like these ones and use them for pretend play.



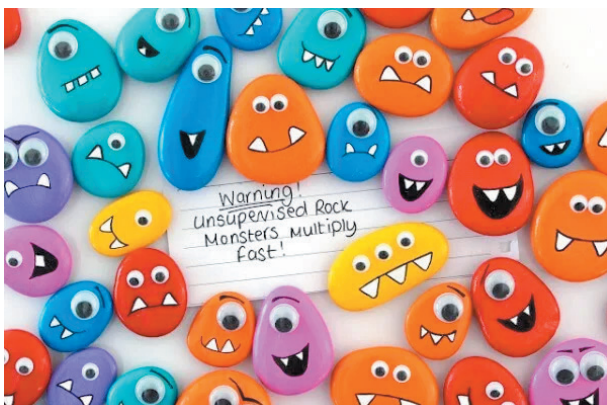
KINDNESS ROCKS FOR KIDS
